



## Policy: Infection Control

### Rational

Infection prevention and control is an important part of safe patient care. The College of Denturists of British Columbia's practice standards state,

*A registrant must demonstrate, at all times, a level of knowledge which ensures the adequate protection of the public. Areas of requisite knowledge are:*

- *sterilization and infection control demonstrate aseptic techniques and environmental controls to ensure adequate hygienic environment.*

Denturists must maintain the standards of practice of the profession and, accordingly, must ensure that appropriate infection prevention and control procedures are carried out in their practices.

### Policy Statement

The College of Denturists of British Columbia has adopted the Denturist Association of Canada's infection control recommendations as the acceptable standards for infection prevention and control in a denturist's practice.
